Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- If you had to put one label on your annual Christmas family gathering, what would it say?
- Do you ever buy anything based mostly on the label? How does the label affect your decision?

Start thinking. Ask questions to get your group thinking.

- Finish this statement, "sticks and stones may break my bones but ...". What do you think about this phrase?
- Read Proverbs 18:21. Why do you think labels are so powerful? What makes them matter?

Start sharing. Choose questions that create openness.

- What are some positive and negative labels you've been given? How is your Heavenly Father naming you something different?
- What difficulty have you experienced that can become a strength for you?
- How are you labeling your kids, coworkers, family, and friends? Do you need to rename anyone like Jacob did in Genesis 35:16-18?

Start praying. Be bold, and pray with power.

- Heavenly Father, You gave up Your son Jesus so we could be called something different. We were too much, not enough, failures, and cheaters. Now You call us Your sons and daughters. Thank You. And will You help us to grow into our new name? Amen.
