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### **Ephesians 1:15-17 (NASB)**

*<sup>15</sup> For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which exists among you and your love for all the saints, <sup>16</sup> do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in my prayers; <sup>17</sup> that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.*

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### **Ephesians 1:18 (NASB)**

*I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,*

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### **Ephesians 1:19-21 (NASB)**

*<sup>19</sup> and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might <sup>20</sup> which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, <sup>21</sup> far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.*

## **Journey Group Discussion**

To experience a revolution in our lives, we must first understand who we are created to be. But it goes far beyond knowledge. We have to put that knowledge into action.

This builds on the first message from this series and shows us how our God-given identity opens up to experience God-driven change. It's not just about knowing who we are in Christ; it's about reaching our full capacity in what He has created us to do!

Review and talk a little about your identity in Christ (if you're a believer) from Ephesians 1:1-14

- How should our identity change our thinking and actions?
- Give examples of how your faith is demonstrated in your love.
- Discuss what praying specifically might look like compared to praying in generalities.
- How would living for God's glory change your priorities?

Read Ephesians 1:18

- How would believing God has called you change the way you think and act?

Read Ephesians 1:19-21

- Why do you think we don't tap into the power available to us?
- If we did, what might change in our daily lives?
- Give an example of a time you think God prompted you to do something for someone or say something to someone.
